◆ 1. Required Components (2.5 points)

- **Focus on a foundational course concept** — Choose a theme or idea central to the Hyperlinked Library model.
- **Clear, engaging writing** — Follows a logical structure; prose is polished and shows effort.
- **Technical quality** — Blog is free of errors (grammar, spelling, formatting).
- **Enhancements included** — Use of images, links, media enriches the post.
- **Proper citations** — Style is consistent; sources are clearly referenced.
- **Submitted on time** — Aligns with course deadlines (June 22).

◆ 2. Connections to Course Content (2.5 points)

- **Includes relevant course materials** — Integrates readings, lectures, videos, and/or peer discussions.
- **Supports ideas with research** — May bring in outside sources where appropriate.
- **Links ideas to library or information practice** — Discussion connects back to the profession and course themes.

◆ 3. Comprehension and Analysis (2.5 points)

- **Demonstrates understanding of course themes** — Thoughtful engagement with key ideas.
- **Offers a personal response** — Reflects your perspective and synthesis of course content.
- **Analyzes chosen topic deeply** — Goes beyond summary; engages critically with concepts.

◆ 4. Progression of Thought and Reflection (2.5 points)

- **Demonstrates learning progression** — Shows how understanding has grown since the start of the course.
- **Innovative or forward-thinking approach** — Sparks ideas for deeper exploration throughout the term.

- **Connects back to professional goals** — Situates the reflection within a broader vision for your library practice.

- **Refer to Module Themes:** Ground your reflection in current or past modules (e.g., Participatory Service, Hyperlinked Communities, Emerging Tech).
- **Use Media Creatively:** Visuals, GIFs, videos, or infographics can enhance your narrative.
- **Reflect Forward:** Let this be a springboard for your Innovation Strategy and other major assignments.
