3.) Infinite Learning

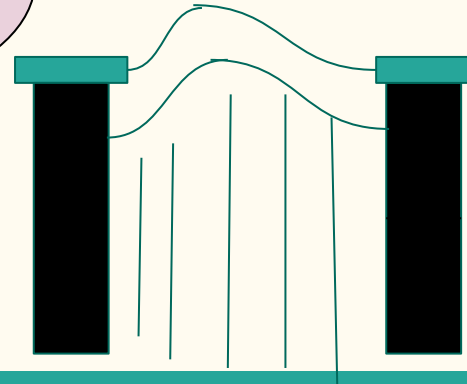
